

Why is EU protection needed?

- Saving lives, environment, money
- Preferably horizontal legislation to cover private and public sectors
- Equal treatment of workers (standard and non-standard jobs)
- Criminal liability, burden of proof, anonymity
- Legal aid, compensation for costs
- Corruption costs the EU 120 bn euros a year!

What we know...

- Directive proposal indicatively coming out 17 April
- It will set out minimum standards
- Not horizontal but not sectoral, however, covering: environmental crimes, data protection, public health, transport safety, EU financial interests
- Extends to private & public sector
- Covering workers in "non-traditional sense" (freelancers, trainees, former workers)
- Tiered approach to reporting channels: internal reporting to be preferred and organisations are obliged to set up reporting channels (exemptions for SMEs)
- Member states should assign competent authorities for reporting No body on EU-level will be assigned
